Terms & Conditions

	Traditional Scheme	Loan Assisted Scheme
1	Up to 4 instalments allowed	Students sign a loan offer agreement with Eduford Microfinance Ltd (EMF).
2	Clearance to zero balance within 90 days from the first day of semester	EMF covers the tuition fees to zero balance, at the beginning of each semester.
3	Pending amounts after 90 days attract a surcharge of 30,000 UGX per week	Students make continuous monthly instalments to EMF starting from the first month of the first semester until the loan is settled.
4	Access all school services upon payment of 75% of tuition	Students must maintain a backup/reserve fund of 600,000 UGX for certificate programs or 1,000,000 UGX for diploma programs, paid separately from the monthly instalments.
5	Exam eligibility requires clearing to zero balance	The reserve fund addresses any missed or skipped instalments, minimizing the risk of disrupting the student's progress due to financial shortfalls. It is finally transferred to the last instalments.

LOAN APPLICATION PROCESS

IN JUST 7 STEPS



1

Account Registration: Use the Student ID on the admission form to open an account with Eduford Microfinance Ltd. Include the sponsor's information or your employment details.

2

Pay Account Opening Fee: Pay the mandatory 20,000 UGX fee using your school pay code.

3

Fill Loan Application Form: Attach relevant documents and await approval.

4

Once approved, review and sign the loan agreement.

5

Make Initial Deposit: Deposit 600,000 UGX (certificate) or 1,000,000 UGX (diploma) as a buffer for potential payment shortfalls. Payable over a period of up to 6 months.

6

Sign a new commitment form at the beginning of each semester to reaffirm the loan terms.

7

Commence Monthly Instalments: Pay monthly instalments of 150,000 UGX as per the loan agreement schedule.
